Introduction

We are so thankful to God for this past year of transformation and proclaiming the gospel to the street children and youth. These vulnerable children and youth have been experiencing the trauma and vulnerability due to the hunger, civil war, intercommunal conflict, economic crisis, and poor parental care in South Sudan. Many of them have come from far states fleeing from war-affected areas to search for any way of survival. Their lives on the streets is truly dreadful and hopeless without Christ.

Good News

In the past four years, Street Children Ministry (SCM) has been an anchor and beacon of hope to children and youth in the capital of South Sudan, Juba. We seek to minister to their spiritual and physical life. We reach out to them and comfort them in their distress. The kids have experienced God's love and mercy through the SCM outreach programs in the streets of Juba. We provide food, clothing and clean their wounds. We engage with them in Biblical counselling and encouragement. The Lord is working in many lives.

Below is a word from one of the young man (23 years old) who joined the street when he was very young due to the loss of his parents. **Sunday** testifies:



I am thankful to God for keeping me safe for so many years in the streets. I fled to Juba when war broke out in 2013. There was no food and my 2 brothers and I were about to die because of hunger. My father died in the war and my mother abandoned us because she was not able to provide food for us and herself. My 2 brothers and I left home to the streets begging people and live a miserable life without parents.

I was devastated and discouraged when I see the life that I lived in. I do not even know where my brothers are. But I thank God for connecting me with Street Children Ministry. I have experienced love and care from the Street Children Ministry. I came to know the Lord and fear Him. Street Children Ministry opened my eyes and I stopped stealing,

begging, and imagining wrong things. Now I am working with the construction company in Gudele and I trust the Lord, He will help me find my 2 brothers who I do not know where they are presently.

We consider it with joy and thankfulness to the Lord for helping them grow in him and perform well in school. This year is the second year for them in school and some of them will remain in 1 B and the rest will go to 1 C, grade 2 and 3.

They are very excited to be back to school. It is always very exciting for us when always hearing them saying "I scored 100% in this subject" and another says, "I scored 98% in this subject but I will beat you in mathematics next time because it is the subject I like so much". And then a very

funny and interesting thing is that, one of the students in 1B said "I will score 150% in mathematics and English when the school start in February 2022" and I will be the best student in 1 C. Another one responded, "Ah no, I will score at least 160% or 170% in our world (social studies) and English and I am going to be the best student".

A simple respond from me, "you are very

good boys and we are always thankful for your performances in school. You are creative and clever boys. You are going to make it successfully this year. But you need to know that the score in each subject is 100% and it does not go beyond 100% like 120%.

The boys are also very eager to build their relationship with God. We are presently developing the residential center for intensive discipleship and care. Many thanks to our supporters for their financial and spiritual for each of these children. We always need your constant prayers that the Lord would provide the resources to finish the building that we would be able to accommodate more children.
