## **REDEEMED CHILDREN SCHOOL (RCS): EMPOWERING THROUGH QUALITY CHRISTIAN EDUCATION**

### **ANNUAL IMPACT NARRATIVE | 2024**

In communities where poverty, displacement, and homelessness rob children of their right to learn, the Redeemed Children School (RCS) stands as a powerful agent of change. This past year, RCS has continued to transform lives through inclusive, accessible, and nurturing education for both street-involved and community children.

Education is one of the most effective long-term interventions for vulnerable children. At RCS, learning is not just about academics, it's about restoring hope and dignity, nurturing potential, and shaping futures.

#### **Our Mission in Action**

##### **1. Inclusive classrooms**

RCS provides a safe and welcoming learning environment for all children, whether coming from homelessness, unstable housing, or disadvantaged local communities. Classrooms are designed to be trauma-sensitive, allowing children to learn at their own pace, with teachers trained to meet emotional and academic needs.

##### **2. Bridging gaps through holistic and quality Christian learning**

Our curriculum includes not only core subjects like Math, English, and Science, but also life skills, hygiene education, and Bible-based moral instruction. In the 2024–2025 school year, RCS enrolled **76 children**, with **25 children** formerly homeless children at the RCH.

##### **3. Meals and care as a foundation**

Some children from the community arrive at school hungry or weak. Redeemed Children's Home provides daily meals, basic health education, and access to psychosocial support; ensuring children are physically and mentally ready to learn.

##### **4. Building community through education**

By integrating local community children with formerly homeless children, RCS promotes understanding, equality, and social healing. It becomes a place where differences are respected, and friendships are formed across backgrounds.



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### **STORY OF IMPACT: A. EZRA**

A. Ezra , age 16, was rescued from a life of begging on the streets with his younger brother. When he joined RCH and RCS, he had never held a pencil, was extremely shy, and didn't know how to read. With time, patience, and daily encouragement, A Ezra began to shine.

Now in his fifth year at RCH and RCS, A. Ezra is among the top in his class, loves storytelling, painting and recently been painting nice pictures for his brothers and other at the RCS.

*"I want to be a teacher one day," he says proudly, "because someone taught me when no one else could."*

His story reminds us why we do this work and how education creates lasting change.

### **2024–2025 IMPACT HIGHLIGHTS**

- Total number of children enrolled: 76
- Former street children reintegrated into classrooms: 25
- Community outreach gatherings Held: 6
- Literacy Improvement Rate: 97%
