REDEEMED CHILDREN'S HOME (RCH): A YEAR OF REDEMPTION AND RESTORATION

ANNUAL IMPACT NARRATIVE | 2024

This past year, the Redeemed Children's Home (RCH) has continued to be a place of hope, healing, and transformation for some of the most vulnerable children in our communities, those who once called the streets their home.

RCH was established as a rehab center, holistic care home for homeless and abandoned children. It offers more than just shelter; it provides a stable, nurturing environment where children can rebuild their lives with dignity. In the 2024–2025 year, we housed **25** children and welcomed **7** new arrivals.

OUR APPROACH TO TRANSFORMATION

1. Safe shelter and daily care

Every child at RCH receives access to clean and secure housing, nutritious meals, clothing, and 24/7 supervision by caring house parents. This consistent, safe environment allows children to rest, grow, and feel secure for the first time in their lives.

2. Emotional & spiritual healing

Daily routines include guided prayer, mentorship, and opportunities for children to express their emotions through play, games, and counseling. RCH integrates spiritual formation and trauma-informed care, helping children rediscover their value and rebuild trust.

3. Education and empowerment

All children who finished grade 4 and 5 at the RCS were enrolled in local schools or tutoring programs, with the necessary supplies and uniforms provided. Some began learning vocational skills, equipping them with tools for long-term independence.

4. Relationship building & family reunification

Our team worked closely with social services to explore family tracing and, when possible, safe reintegration with relatives. We also facilitated regular visits and support for children transitioning to foster care or permanent homes.

Stories that inspire: Gabriel's journey

At just 9 years old, Gabriel arrived at RCH after living alone on the streets for two years. He was quiet, and suffered from untreated infections. But with consistent care, counseling, and love, Gabriel began to grow.

Now 12, he is healthy, grow in school, and full of life. He's especially passionate about science and dreams of becoming a doctor in the future.

"I want to take care of other kids the way SCM took care of me," Gabriel told us.

His story is an encouragement to what can happen when a child is given a second chance and a loving home.
