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Overview

The Redeemed Children's School (RCS) continues to be a beacon of hope for children who once lived without access to education, love, or guidance. Over the past six months, the school has not only provided quality Christian-based education but has also cultivated an environment of transformation spiritually, academically, and emotionally. The progress seen among our students and teachers testifies to God's faithfulness and the community's growing trust in our mission.

Enrollment and Attendance

As of this year 2025, RCS has over 120 children but some drop out due to unforeseen circumstances. Currently, there are 110 students in total of which 63 are boys and 27 are girls across different grade levels.

- This year Admissions: over 100 and 35 children from the RCH and nearby vulnerable families.
- Attendance Rate: 96% average weekly attendance
- Retention Rate: 60-70%, indicating strong parental and guardian engagement. The steady enrollment growth underscores RCS's vital role in providing accessible and inclusive education for disadvantaged children.





Academic Achievements

- Term Performance: Over 80% of students achieved above-average results in core subjects (English, Mathematics, Science, and Christian Religious Education).
- Literacy & Numeracy Gains: most students who previously struggled with reading are now confidently reading short passages aloud.
- Teacher Development: 5 teachers participated in an internal training and workshop on the curriculum and professional classroom management.
- Term Highlights:
 - A successful dictation, reading, and soccer day motivated younger learners.
 - Upper-class students conducted peer teaching sessions, nurturing leadership and confidence.

Faith and Character Formation

The foundation of RCS remains rooted in Christian values.

- Daily devotions: conducted every Monday through Friday, emphasizing important of prayer, Bible stories, and discipline.
- Bible Verse Memorization: all the students memorize Bible verses.
- Student Testimonies: Many children shared personal stories of change especially those previously rescued from the streets who now find purpose and belonging in Christ.

One touching story is that of **Giben**, a 12-year-old formerly homeless boy. Once shy and reserved, Giben now leads morning prayers and dreams of becoming a teacher to inspire others like him.



Infrastructure and Learning Environment

Significant improvements have been made to ensure a safe and conducive learning space:

- Classrooms were freshly cemented and expanded.
- Additional desks and benches were crafted through the Vocational Skills Training (VST) carpentry program.
- A shaded outdoor learning area was established to ease classroom congestion.

These efforts have created a warm, vibrant environment where learning thrives.

Staff and Administration

RCS currently has 6 dedicated teaching staff and 1 administrative staff (Lydia Agany).

- Staff morale remains high despite limited resources.
- Teachers are actively mentoring pupils not only academically but also in personal growth and Christian discipline.
- The school administrator introduced an improved reporting and parent communication system, which has strengthened school-community ties.

Extracurricular Activities

RCS prioritizes holistic development:

- **Sports:** our school and RCH football team won some friendly community match.
- **Community Engagement:** the students participated in a neighborhood clean-up and awareness campaign about hygiene and respect.

Challenges

While progress has been inspiring, several challenges remain:

1. Limited learning materials especially textbooks for Science and Mathematics.
2. Overcrowded classrooms, with some grades exceeding 30 pupils per class.
3. Need for a school feeding program, as many children from the community arrive hungry and struggle to concentrate.

Future Goals (2026)

- Introduce a daily feeding program through partnership with donors.
- Expand classroom blocks to accommodate growing enrollment.
- Strengthen teacher professional development through training in child psychology and trauma-informed education.
- Establish a computer literacy unit to introduce basic IT skills.
- Enhance parental engagement through regular meetings and family visits.
